First appearing on currency in the fourteenth century, its symbolism extends into many aspects of British life.

Reverse

The Royal Arms are the Arms of the monarch and identify the Head of State of the United Kingdom.

Beneath the lion and unicorn is the motto of English monarchs – 'Dieu et mon droit' ('God and my right') – while the shield displays the motto of the Order of the Garter – 'Honi soit qui mal y pense' ('shame upon him who thinks evil upon it').



A symbol of Her Majesty's Government, The Royal Arms appears on all government communications and documents.

The shield forms the centrepiece of the Royal Arms. England is represented by three lions, the lion rampant is for Scotland, and the harp is Ireland's symbol.

Struck in 999 fine silver reflected in the coin's inscription.
